Mononk Jules puts back together some of lesser known pieces of Indigenous History, the parts that are not taught. Jocelyn Sioui fasten the threads of his great-uncle's story, who was one of the greatest native heroes of the 20th century, who fell into a gap in our collective memory.

Jules Sioui's combat led him to sacrifice his life in a series of hunger strikes for the independance of indigenous people. Surrounded by screens and models where historical figures and images come to life, Jocelyn Sioui takes us at the bottom of an archive box, from which we emerge changed. Funny, touching, energetic, *Mononk Jules* is a captivating story delivered with great authenticity.
