



Little lockdown legends

Technical sheet – outdoor show

Target audience: 5 years and older

Recommended number of spectators: 60 to 90 people

Content of the show: 3 tales (they can be presented in solo, duo, or trio)

Expected duration of the show: approximately 25 minutes per tale, with a 10 minutes break between each tale if they are presented on the same table.

Number of people on stage: 1 comedian per tale

Technical crew: 1 stage manager

Playing area: approximately 9' X 9'

Technical equipment provided by Motus:

- 1 speaker
- 1 wireless microphone per comedian
- 1 table 6 feet long and 3 feet wide

Technical equipment to be provided:

- An electrical hook-up (at least 4 outlets available)
- If possible, a tent or tarp in case of rain or strong sun

Please note, in case of rain or wind, as the puppets are made of paper, the show cannot take place outside.

Manipulation: the sound will be adjusted before the performance by Motus team

Set: the set and props fit entirely on our table

Set-up and strike:

- Set up takes about 30 minutes
- Strike is done in about 15 minutes

Location: if you can find a location with some "privacy" where there are not too many noises or distractions, the audience will have a better experience.

Other needs:

- The team will need to know where to park their car
- A dressing room/bathroom to change
