TREE: A WORLD IN ITSELF, IS A MULTI-SENSORY, INTERACTIVE UNIVERSE ENVELOPED IN SOFT LIGHT, MUSIC, AND SILENCE, WHERE FIVE CHARACTERS CONTINUALLY ADAPT TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THEIR AUDIENCE.



IN AN INTIMATE AND WELCOMING ATMOSPHERE, THE PERFORMANCE OFFERS A RATIO OF ONE PERFORMING ARTIST PER CHILD TO FACILITATE NUMEROUS PERSONALIZED INTERACTIONS WITH AUDIENCE MEMBERS. PLEASE NOTE THAT CHILDREN MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT; A FRIEND OR A SIBLING IS ALSO PERMITTED TO ATTEND.
